Dear Mr. Turner and Committee Members,

Re: Application for modification of MPSCS mobile license WPIH522.

The Communications Division of the Michigan Department of Information Technology (MDIT) represents the Michigan Public Safety Communications System (MPSCS), and the Michigan Department of State Police (MSP) in matters relating to FCC licenses.

The Communications Division is submitting an application for modification of existing MPSCS license, **WPIH522**. This application adds already licensed frequencies to this statewide trunked radio system mobile and control station license.

The Committee has previously approved the corresponding repeater frequencies and the listed mobile and control station frequencies for use by the MPSCS.

These mobile and control station frequencies are currently listed on existing individual site licenses. This application consolidates these mobile and control station frequencies on a single license for ease of tracking and maintenance. The application also makes these frequencies statewide for mobile and control station usage. This will eliminate some licensing anomalies which result from the statewide nature of MPSCS. The frequencies will subsequently be removed from the individual site licenses.

Again, this is not a request for additional frequencies, just a consolidation of already granted frequencies onto a single license. We ask the committee to review this application at the next scheduled committee meeting and provide a letter of approval.
