Re: Application for modification of MPSCS mobile license WPIH522.

The Communications Division of the Michigan Department of Information Technology (MDIT) represents the Michigan Public Safety Communications System (MPSCS), and the Michigan Department of State Police (MSP) in matters relating to FCC licenses.

The Communications Division is submitting an application for modification of existing MPSCS license, WPIH522. This application adds additional channels to one of the statewide trunked radio system mobile and control station licenses.

A number of frequencies have been added or changed at various MPSCS base sites. This modification updates the appropriate license to add corresponding mobile and control station frequencies.

We are also deleting the analog mutual aid channels from this digital trunking (YF class) license as we have obtained a separate license (WQDV891) for the analog mutual aid (GF class) mobile and control station frequencies.

We ask the committee to review this application at the next scheduled committee meeting and provide a letter of approval.
